March 10, 2020

1. Town Board Budget Requests (Deb Nelson will attend the March 18th 6:00 PM Town Board meeting and present the ask)
 - a. Funding for flowers - \$800
 - b. Re-useable bags - \$660 – Town of Cable Logo on one side
 - c. Printing of Walking Maps - \$600
 - d. Printing (2) Cable maps to put on CAMBA and Rivers Eatery Kiosks – they would be 24'x 24' metal - \$77 a piece = \$154.00

2. Discussion regarding re-useable coffee mugs – 4 – 6 possible sites to sell – Velo, Brickhouse, R-Place Café, Cable Café, Museum – Each business would buy part of the 100 printed. They would have the Town of Cable logo on them encouraging sustainability – we would be establishing a re-use business partnership. Wholesale cost with log would be approximately \$7.00 Elizabeth Holland is researching mug types.

3. Re-useable Bags:
 - a. Best deal Elizabeth Holland found was from World Wildlife Fund Bag
 - b. Size – 14 x 6.75 x 15.75 laminated looking bag
 - c. 2000 minimum order
 - d. All sides printed on – full color
 - e. Cost \$2.00 per bag – includes shipping
 - f. Sounds too good to be true – Elizabeth is checking further
 - g. Budget:
 - i. \$1,890 in the Town of Cable bank
 - ii. \$1,5600 – 16 sponsors @ \$100 per sponsor – these would be listed on the inside sides of the bags
 - iii. \$660 – Town of Drummond – one side
 - iv. \$660 – Town of Cable – one side

4. North and South entry signs into Cable:
 - a. Sue Thurn will contact three community members (Sara Balbin, Kevin Podvin and Rick Gruel regarding their ideas on signage.

5. Legion Veterans Triangle:
 - a. We will take this off our to do list
 - b. Sara Balbin is working with the Legion regarding the Placemaking project at the Triangle

6. Cable Business gathering:

- a. We have not heard from Cyndi K. regarding the date of the Business gathering at Micks. Sue Thurn will contact Cyndi and ask how we can help and encourage her to involve the Chamber.
