MAY 12, $2020 - SPECIAL 7^{TH} DISTRICT ELECTION$

The May 12, 2020 Special 7th District Election is to elect a new Congressional Representative to replace Congressman Sean Duffy.

In order to protect voters and poll workers as much as possible, the May 12, 2020 election in Cable will be held with DRIVE-THRU VOTING. Voting will be set up in the entryway of the Community Centre. The process is as follows:

- 1. PLEASE DRIVE TO THE COMMUNITY CENTRE DOOR FROM THE PARKING LOT. THE ENTRY TO THE COMMUNITY CENTRE PARKING LOT FROM COUNTY HIGHWAY M WILL BE A ONE-WAY EXIT ON ELECTION DAY.
- 2. You do not need to get out of your car.
- 3. A poll worker will come to your car and check your ID through the window.
- 4. The poll worker will then hand you the poll book on a clip board and ask you to sign by your name. You will be given a pen to use to sign the poll book and to vote your ballot. Then keep the pen you used.
- 5. After you vote, a second poll worker will ask you to slide your ballot face down onto a protective envelope sleeve. The poll worker will then step into the entryway of the Community Centre to put your ballot in the scanning machine.

You are done!

This process will ensure that voters are able to stay in their own space in their cars and still be able to vote. The process is also the least amount of exposure for poll workers. Thank you for all your cooperation at the April 7, 2020 and now for the May 12 election!!
