May Monthly Road & Property Report

Spring is here, and so is the spring time work. We hired Kyle Hawk for the seasonal position. He has been working steadily to get all the lawns cleaned up for the season. The weight limits came off our roads on 4/26, so we have been getting the sand blown off the roads and getting the village streets swept. Along with the sweeping, we have been grading roads as we can. We desperately need some rain to calm the dust down and to put some moisture back in our gravel roads so they can be graded. The park is open for use. The tennis court nets are up, the water is on in the depot and it is open daily for park users. The public restrooms at the municipal lot are also open and ready for use. We had all 3 docks put in before the fishing opener. Two of our boat landings need some minor maintenance, the frost left quite the speed bump at the top of the landings at Perry Lake and Cable Lake.

We still have a pile of maintenance work lined up before we can start on this year's road projects. We will be crack sealing with the Town of Namakagon shortly, painting lines in the village, patching, grading, prepping for the gravel crushing at our shop, upgrading the lighting in the depot bathrooms, cleanup on Short Rd., sealing sidewalks, resealing the mural, plus many more tasks on our list.

We will be interviewing applicants during the week of May 17th for the open full time roadcrew position. Hopefully the person that is selected will be able to start at least by the beginning of June. This year is going to be a busy year, we have a pretty aggressive maintenance, construction plan for this year. I'll try to get messages out through the town website and facebook to keep people informed on construction areas to avoid. Enjoy the spring weather.
