Whereas, The Road & Property Foreman has developed a Road Crew Training Plan to identify training and qualification requirements for operators of this equipment to ensure correct use of all equipment and safe operating procedures for its workers, a copy of which is submitted with this resolution and

Whereas, Successful completion of the Road Crew Training Plan shall be required by all current and future employees of the Town Road Crew prior to use of any equipment covered by the Road Crew Training Plan; and

Whereas, The Road Crew Training Plan conforms to the training requirements of the U.S. Mine Safety & Health Administration and the U.S. Occupational Safety & Health Administration; and

Whereas, The Road & Property Foreman shall review and update the Road Crew Training Plan annually to ensure compliance with all governing rules and regulations and to include any additional pieces of equipment obtained by the Town and shall report to the Town Board; now therefore, be it

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### **Resolution revoking Ordinance #38-17, Liquor License Ordinance.**

Whereas, On October 12, 2017, the Town Board of Cable adopted Ordinance #38-17, the Liquor License Ordinance, to address possible revocation or surrender of "Class B" liquor licenses that were issued to businesses that were not in operation for a long period of time; and

Whereas, Issuance of liquor licenses is delegated to municipalities by Ch. 125, Wis. Stats., but this statutes permits municipalities to establish license fees and additional license requirements such as the requirement authorized by Ordinance #38-17; and

Whereas, Review of Town of Cable Ordinances found that fees for licenses permitted under Ch. 125, Wis. Stats., had not been adopted by the Town Board: and

Whereas, A proposed ordinance to fully address the fees and policies for issuance of licenses under Chapter 125, Wis. Stats., and to permit issuance of retail cigarette and tobacco licenses under Ch. 134.65, Wis. Stats, is to be presented concurrently to the Town Board with this resolution; and

Whereas, The proposed ordinance for Retail Liquor and Tobacco Sales incorporates the provisions of Ordinance #38-17 so that the Ordinance is not longer needed; now, therefore, be it .

Resolved, by the Town of Cable Board, That Ordinance #38-17, the Liquor License Ordinance is revoked.

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**Resolution adopting the Retail Liquor and Cigarette License Ordinance.**

Whereas, The retail licensing of alcoholic beverages and cigarette and tobacco sales are regulated by Wisconsin Statutes, and implemented by the clerks of the governing municipality; and

Whereas, Ch. 125, Wis. Stats., authorizes municipalities to establish license fees and prescribe additional regulations for the sale of alcoholic beverages; and

Whereas, Ch. 134.65, Wis. Stats, governs the retail licensing of cigarette and tobacco products by municipal clerks and authorizes municipalities to establish license fees and violation fines; and

Whereas, Notice of consideration of the adoption of the Retail the Retail Liquor and Cigarette License Ordinance, Town of Cable, Code of Ordinance as prescribed by Wis. Stats.; now, therefore, be it .

Resolved, by the Town of Cable Board, That the following ordinance is adopted on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides the authority for the town to prepare and enact the Retail Liquor and Cigarette License Ordinance attached hereto; and, be it

Further Resolved, The Town Clerk is directed to publish and post the ordinance as prescribed by Wis. Stats.

Ordinance #45-20  
Retail Liquor and Cigarette License Ordinance

Section I: Title

Town of Cable Retail Liquor and Cigarette License Ordinance.

Section II: Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is for the Town of Cable to:

1. to adopt and incorporate the provisions of Ch. 125, Wis. Stats, relating to the retail sale of intoxicating liquor and fermented malt beverages as part of the Town of Cable Ordinances,
2. to impose additional restrictions on the granting, renewal and revocation of licenses as permitted by Ch. 125, Wis. Stats.,
3. to establish fees for liquor licenses issued pursuant to Ch. 125, Wis. Stats.
4. to establish fees for cigarette license issued pursuant to Ch. 134.65, Wis. Stats. and fines for violation of Ch. 134.65, Wis. Stats.

Section III: Adoption of Ch. 125, Wis Stats.

Ch. 125, Wis. Stats, Alcohol Beverages, is hereby adopted by the Town of Cable and the provisions therein are incorporated in the Ordinances of the Town of Cable to govern the application, issuance, revocation of licenses governing the retail sale of alcohol beverages. Future changes to Ch. 125, Wis. Stats. made by the Wisconsin Legislature shall be incorporated in the Town of Cable Ordinances without further action of the Town Board.

Section IV: Retail Liquor License Fees

a. Fees for retail liquor license year beginning on July 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021 shall be as follows:

Class "A" Fermented Malt Beverages	\$ 50.00	Per Year
Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverages	\$ 75.00	Per Year
Temporary Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverages (aka "Picnic License")	\$ 10.00	Per Event
Temporary Class "B" Wine	\$ 10.00	Per Event
"Class A" Intoxicating Liquor	\$ 200.00	Per Year
"Class B" Intoxicating Liquor	\$ 400.00	Per Year
"Class B" Intoxicating Liquor - Reserve license Initial submission fee	\$ 10,000.00	Per initial application
"Class C" Wine	\$ 75.00	Per Year
Operator License	\$ 10.00	Per Year

- b. Fees for retail liquor licenses issued beginning July 1, 2021 shall be established by resolution of the Town of Cable adopted at the time of adoption of the annual Town Budget.

Section V: Business Continuation

- a. Business Continuation Period.

A holder of a liquor license issued by the Town of Cable shall be required to continue to operate its business for which the liquor license was issued for a minimum of 120 days and for a minimum of five (5) hours for public business on each those 120 days during the current licensing year as a condition of the liquor license.

- b. Business Interruption due to catastrophe or natural disaster.

A licensee who fails to maintain the minimum Business Continuation Period due to property catastrophe or natural disaster including but not limited to, fire, weather storm, or flooding, that damages or destroys all or part of the premises, or health crisis declaration, any of which prevents the licensee from operating in a manner safe to the general public may request the Town Board waive the Business Continuation Period for a period of time determined to be necessary by the Town Board to allow the licensee to repair or rebuild the premises.

- c. Violation of Business Continuation.

In the event a licensee violates this section, the Town Board shall notify the Licensee of the violation and shall be permitted to revoke, suspend or non renew the license as permitted by Ch. 125,12, Wis. Stats.

VI: Liquor License Availability.

In the event that the Town of Cable has issued all available "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor licenses as determined by Quota but subsequently determines a "Class B" license becomes available due to surrender or revocation, the Town Clerk shall post and publish the license availability with 90 days of termination of the license.

VIII. Cigarette License Fees and Fines

- a. Fees for retail cigarette license and license violations shall be:

Cigarette License Fee	\$ 5.00 per year
Cigarette License Violation Fines	\$ 25.00 first offense \$ 50.00 second offense \$ 75.00 all subsequent offenses

- b. Fees for retail liquor licenses issued beginning July 1, 2021 shall be established by resolution of the Town of Cable adopted at the time of adoption of the annual Town Budget.

VIII: Delinquent Municipal Payments.

The Town Board shall deny a new license or a license renewal for an applicant has any delinquent municipal taxes, assessments or other fees due the Town of Cable.

IX: Severability.

In the event any portion of this ordinance is or becomes invalid or illegal, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

X. Effective Date.

The effective date for this ordinance is effective on publication or posting as permitted by Wisconsin Statutes.
