- President Popelka shared an e-mail from Mark Deraney of AMKO Financial Services stating that they will not have the offer ready for refinancing the USDA loan until the June meeting. Therefore the matter of the refinancing of the loan has been tabled until next month.

### 11. New Business

President Popelka reported that as a result of a visit to the site of the new
Higgins building at corner of Hwy 63 and M, it has been discovered that there
is apparent encroachment on the Sanitary District's permanent easement to
the east of the building. Three rather large trees have been planted directly on
top of the sewer laterals serving 5 business on Kavanaugh Rd and two large
trees have been planted within the easement closest to the building.

Following discussion and review of photographs taken at the the site, a motion was made by President Popelka that due to potential damage to the sanitary district system, a letter shall be written to the Town of Cable Board with regard to encroachment on the easement on parcel 37649 to advise them first, that the recently planted trees on said easement can remain only if the property stays in Town of Cable ownership and secondly, that the Town of Cable is responsible for any remediation of damages to the sewer system caused by the tree roots. The Sanitary District Commission's prime objective is to protect the sanitary sewer system and the town's investment in the infrastructure. This motion was seconded by Dixon and carried.

**11. Closed Session** - President Popelka made a motion at 4:27 p.m. to enter a closed session in compliance with WI Statute 19.85(1)(f). This motion was seconded by

Jeannie Dixon and carried. Following closed session discussion, David Popelka made a motion to adjourn the closed session and rejoin the open session meeting at 4:45 p.m. This motion was seconded by Dixon and carried. There were no actions to be taken as a result of the closed session.

- **12. Next meeting -** The next meeting of the Town of Cable Sanitary District #1 is scheduled for Wednesday, June 9, 2021 at 3:00 pm at the District Office.
- **13. Adjournment -** President Popelka adjourned the meeting at 4:46 p.m.
