DRIVE-UP VOTING at the Cable Community Centre
will be used for the August 11, 2020 election to protect voters and poll workers
as much as possible. The process is as follows:

1. Enter the Community Centre parking lot from Spruce Street on the west side of the lot. Access from County Highway M will be blocked.
2. Drive to the door of the Community Centre. Stay in your car. Have your photo ID ready.
3. A poll worker will come to your car and check your ID through the window. Upon confirmation of your identity, the poll worker will hand you the Poll Book and pen and will ask you to sign the Poll Book by your name. Keep the pen after signature.
4. A different poll worker will provide you with your ballot on a clipboard. After voting, turn the ballot upside down on the clipboard.
5. After you vote, a poll worker will ask you to slide the clipboard with your ballot face down into a protective sleeve. The poll worker will then return to the Community Centre entry and will feed your ballot into the scanning machine.

The polling place is accessible to elderly and disabled voters.

Notice of Meeting of the Local and Municipal Board of Canvassers

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as a joint meeting of the Local Board of Canvassers and the Municipal Board

of Canvassers for the purpose of conducting the local and municipal canvasses pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§7.51 and 7.53(1).

This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
