

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AND RESTRICTING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN SECTION 18 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CABLE.

The Town Board of the Town of Cable, meeting in regular session this 14th day of September, 1989, does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Cable, is of the opinion, that it is contrary to the health, safety and welfare of the residents and visitors of the Town of Cable, that firearms, due to their inherent danger, be not discharged within Section 18 of the Township of Cable;

WHEREAS, the concern for the safety of the citizens and visitors of the Township of Cable regarding Section 18, relates directly to the congested nature of the former Village of Cable and that the discharge of firearms within said former Village boundaries is not consistent with the general health and welfare of the residents and visitors of said location.

THEREFORE, be it ordained that the discharge of firearms within Section 18 of the Township of Cable, which includes the former Village of Cable, is hereby prohibited and restricted, and that there shall be no discharge within said boundaries of any firearms without the express written consent of the Constable of the Town of Cable, or the Town Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that any person convicted of violating this Ordinance by discharging a firearm within the boundaries set forth above, shall be fined not less than \$ 25.00, nor more than \$ 50.00 for each offense, each day that the firearm is discharged shall constitute a new offense and repeat offenders shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$ 50.00 and not greater than \$ 100.00, if said repeat offense is committed within three years of the preceeding offense.
