

ORDINANCE NO. 17-93

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING
FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF OBSOLETE PUBLIC RECORDS

COPY

WHEREAS, the Town Board is of the opinion that it is impracticable to retain all public records indefinitely;

WHEREAS, State Statute does not dictate for the destruction of obsolete public records;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Cable hereby provides for the destruction of obsolete public records pursuant to S60.83 and S19.21 (4)(a)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

- 1) Election materials shall be destroyed in accordance with S7.23.
- 2) All other records may be destroyed after seven years with the following exceptions -- minute books, assessment rolls, journals, ledgers, maps, deeds, easements, and liquor license applications.
- 3) Notice of such destruction shall be given in writing to the historical society at least 60 days prior.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect after passage, posting, and/or publication as provided by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Cable on August 18, 1993.
