



ORDINANCE NO. 20-97 WINTER PARKING ORDINANCE


- (1) No person may park, abandon, or leave unattended, any motor vehicle, trailer, snowmobile or any other device on any highway, road right-away, alley or street within the Town of Cable, from the first day of November of each and every year to the fifteenth day of April of the subsequent year.
- (2) Exception, The Town shall authorized designated parking hours on individual highways, roads and streets when posted with official signs.
- (3) In the event any motor vehicle, trailer, snowmobile or other device found unattended in violation of this ordinance the Town Chairman, Town Supervisors and Town Constable of the Town of Cable, are authorized to remove or cause to be removed such obstruction and have such obstruction towed away at the owners expense.
- (4) Any person who violates this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$25 dollars nor more than \$50 dollars for the first offense, and not less than \$ 50 dollars nor more than \$ 100 dollars for the second or subsequent offenses.

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and publication as provided by law.




