ORDINANCE NO. 22-97

REGULATING THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS IN THE TOWN OF CABLE

- (1) (a) The owner, occupant, or person in charge of all real estate abutting public sidewalks are required to clear the sidewalks of all snow and ice within 24 hours from the time the snow ceases to accumulate on said sidewalk.
 - (b) In the event that ice has formed on any sidewalk in such a manner that it cannot be removed, the owner, occupant or person in charge of the parcel or lot which fronts upon or adjoins said sidewalk shall keep the sidewalk sprinkled with material to accelerate melting or prevent slipping.
- (2) Snow which is removed from public sidewalks may be deposited on public streets only from 7:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. Persons depositing snow and ice on public streets at any other time, will be subject to the penalties specified in Ordinance #21-97.
- (3) Owners who fail to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined \$20.00 for each violation. Each twenty-four (24) hour period where a violation of Subsection (1) exists, shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, expenses incurred by the Town to remove the snow and/or ice shall be charged to the property owner. Within sixty (60) days after such expenses are incurred and remain unpaid, the Town Clerk shall enter those charges onto the tax roll as a special tax as provided by Sec. 66.615(5) of the WI Statutes.

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
