NOTICE OF PASSAGE OF ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Cable, Bayfield County, Wisconsin ordains as follows:

That the minimum shall be 50 (fifty) feet for private streets in subdivisions, condominiums and similar housing projects in the following designated areas:

- The Southeast quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, Township 43 North, Range 7 West.
- The North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 43 North, Range 7 West.

Any person, firm or corporation who fails to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$200.00 and the costs of prosecution for each violation, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County jail until payment thereof, but not exceeding 30 days. Each day a violation exists or continues shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, the remedies provided by Statutes 236.30 and 236.31 of the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin shall be available to the Town.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon date of posting.
