

An Ordinance to Prohibit the Spraying of Herbicides and Defoliants.

Part 1. Ordinance No. 6 of the Town of Cable is hereby created as follows:

I. Definitions:

a. "Defoliant" means any pesticide labeled, designed or intended for use in causing the leaves or foliage to drop from a plant with or without causing abscission.

b. "Herbicide" means any substance or mixture of substances labeled, designed or intended for use in preventing, destroying, repelling or mitigating any weed.

c. "Use" means the application of a defoliant or herbicide in any manner but excluding manufacturing or formulating processes and yard and noncommercial garden applications.

II. It shall be unlawful in the Town of Cable for any persons to use any defoliant or herbicide within the easement area for any public utility easement or within the easement area for any public roadways or highways.

III. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

Part 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Part 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication or posting.
