RESOLUTION FOR TOWN OF CABLE TO ABANDON
MCCORMICK PROPERTY ACCESS STUB ON EVERGREEN COURT

WHEREAS, the Evergreen Court access to Lots 85, 87, 88, 89, 90-CSM (certified survey map) #1383 on Evergreen Court is platted property, it is not considered a road; and

WHEREAS, the Evergreen Court platted property access to Lots 86, 87, 88, 89, 90 is not being serviced by the Town of Cable; and


WHEREAS, the Evergreen Court platted property access to Lots 86, 87, 88, 89, 90 is not on the Bayfield County Emergency Map; and

WHEREAS, Mary McCormick, sole owner of Lots 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, has petitioned the Town of Cable to abandon and privatize the Evergreen Court platted property access which only serves as access to her home and property; and

WHEREAS, there are no other property owners who access the Evergreen Court platted property access on the south side of the South Ridge in Wilde River Development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the authority vested in the Town Board by Wisconsin Statutes 66.1003; the Town Board of Cable adopts Resolution 2022-01 for Evergreen Court platted property in Sec. 22, T5#, Rg7W, Wilde River Recreational Development, Southridge Addition, lots 86, 87, 88, 89, 90-CSM #1383 Evergreen Court, to be hereby vacated and abandoned by the Town of Cable and that ownership of the Evergreen Court platted property access on the south side of South Ridge in Wilde River Development be reverted to Mary McCormick.




