## **ORDINANCE #2023-01**

# TOWN OF CABLE DUTIES OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER ORDINANCE

STATE OF WISCONSIN, Town of Cable, Bayfield County,

#### SECTION I - TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the "Town of Cable Duties of the Town Enforcement Officer Ordinance". The purpose of the ordinance is to establish the jurisdiction and duties of the Enforcement Officer.

#### SECTION II - AUTHORITY

The Town Board has the authority under its Town powers under s.60.22, Wis.Stats., and the specific authority under s.60.23(30), and Chapters 173 and 174m Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

### SECTION III - ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides guidelines for the Town Enforcement Officer.

# SECTION IV - 0 SUBDIVISION AND NUMBERING OF THIS ORDINANCE

This ordinance is divided into sections designated by uppercase Roman Numerals. Sections may be divided into subsections designated by number. Paragraphs may be divided into subsections designated by lowercase letters. Subdivisions may be divided into subdivision paragraphs designated by lowercase Roman Numerals. Reference to a "section", "subsection", "paragraph", or "subdivision" includes all divisions of the referenced section, subsection, paragraph, or subdivision.

# SECTION V - DUTIES OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

- 1. Report, investigate and enforce violations of the town ordinances as required.
- 2. Report criminal activity and traffic violations to the Bayfield County Sheriff's Department.
- When requested by Bayfield County Sheriff, assist with incident traffic control with the tow, as directed by the Deputy in charge.
- 4. When requested by Great Divide Ambulance, provide assistance within the town.
- 5. When requested by the Town of Cable Fire Department, provide assistance as assigned by the Fire Chief.
- 6. Provide security and traffic control at town special events as requested and assigned by the Town Board.
- 7. Report and investigate town nuisance complaints.
- 8. Report and investigate town firework complaints.
- 9. Make periodic patrols of public boat landings within the town.
- 10. Make periodic patrols of town roads and report public safety hazards and/or road hazards.
- 11. Reports and investigate town ordinance animal complaints.
- 12. Reports and investigate ATV/UTV complaints.
- 13. Report and investigate snowmobile complaints.
- 14. Make periodic property checks of town owned property such as the town park and cemetery.
- 15. Perform other duties as required by town ordinance, law or by the Town of Cable Board.
- 16. In the event of a storm with damage, assist the Town of Cable with road closures and tree removal from said roads.

#### SECTION VI - SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the ordinance are severable.

#### SECTION VII - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
