

Resolution No. 2026-03 by Electors per s.60.10(2)(f) of
WI Statutes to Authorize the Construction of a Pavillion on the Old School Greenspace at a
Special Town Meeting of the Electors

Town of Cable, Bayfield County

Whereas, s.60.10(2)(f) of Wis. Statutes authorizes electors at a special town meeting of electors to have authority to authorize the construction of a building for the use of the town; and

Whereas, the property located at 43430 Kavanaugh Rd, Tax ID 37418, specifically the Town of Cable Lot 2, CSM #1967 in V.11.P317 located in S18, T43N, R07W, is deeded to the Town of Cable and requires the Town Board have approval of constructing the building for recreation, events and other activities , as deemed appropriate by approval or permit; and

Whereas, a properly noticed special town meeting of electors has been called and properly noticed for 25th day of June 2026, the electors approved authorization for the Town Board of the Town of Cable to construct a pavilion on the existing Old School Greenspace pursuant to s.60.10(2)(f), Wis Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the special town meeting of the electors of the Town of Cable, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 25th day of June 2026, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

The town board of the Town of Cable, Bayfield County, Wisconsin is hereby authorized by the electors of the Town of Cable to construct a pavilion on the existing Old School Greenspace.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under s.60.80(1)(a), Wis Statutes within 30 days of adoption.
